This event will be judged by **Oonagh Barrett** and **Bridget Harney** from the Great Irish Bake off 2013 in the following categories:

- 1 - Best Bread - can be brown or white soda, yeast etc.
- 2 - Best Cake - can be plain, fruit, decorated etc
- 3 - Best Bake - Junior category (under 14) - any bake at all

Simply make your bake at home and register at the baking demo area by 3pm at the latest for judging. (results will be announced later in the afternoon, after dedicated tastings..it's a tough job...). There will be rosettes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each category and for the 1st prize winners a free cooking class at "Oonaghs Kitchen" (www.oonaghskitchen.ie)!!!

Oonagh and Bridget will also be doing 2 cookery demonstrations, at 2pm and 4 pm. There will be tastings, and they will be on hand all afternoon to answer any of your baking and cooking queries.

Oonagh Barrett cooks and teaches classes from Oonagh's Kitchen in Kellistown Carlow, and writes a weekly cooking column for 'The Nationalist'. She is known for her passion for flavours in all aspects of baking and cooking.

Bridget Harney is a baker with a flair for the delicate and quirky. She writes a food blog, 'The search For Delicious', and bakes for the Duck and Cup Cafe.

From Carlow take the R726 Hacketstown Road for 10km to Killeric Cross Roads. Turn left at this junction onto the R418 for 2.5km, turn left again at the signed junction.




Kidz Zone
